

The Value of Latin and the GRE

LATIN holds its top position

On the web GRE test scores are posted of college seniors. They are grouped into about 300 or so degree majors. Figures show that ...

Classical Language students earned the TOP average for verbal sections!
They also scored higher in quantitative test than any other language major and better than *scores* of other areas!

They earned the third highest score for Analytical Writing, just below History of Science and Philosophy majors!

Results for those who tested between 2005 and 2008 and 1996 to 1999 are summarized below.
