The National Latin Teacher Recruitment Week committee is making available to all Latin teachers (K-college) in the United States and Canada mini-grants of up to \$200.00 each to support efforts at the local level designed to encourage students to consider a career as a Latin teacher.

These efforts are part of a movement that is National Latin Teacher Recruitment Week but may be held at any time during the school year. Examples of fundable ideas would include postage for a mailing, refreshments for a reception, travel funds for a speaker, promotional materials, etc.

In fact, these funds can be used to purchase

NLTRW mini-buttons, t-shirts, mugs, and more for giveaways and drawings. The materials this year feature these phrases: habesne Latinam?, carpe diem, doceo: what do you do?, and veni, vidi, vici. Each designed is encircled
