You have seen how many English words are **BORROWED WORDS** from Latin. Many more have very small changes in spelling when they come into English.

For example, here are some ending changes:

-tas=>ty *brevitas, gravitas, claritas*

-tio -tiones (pl) or sio -siones => n *eruptio, animatio, regio, oratio*

-o (dropped in English) *resisto, insisto, repello, importo, exporto, reporto*

-us, -is or a =>drop or add - e *longus, primus*

or other small changes..... Try these that I only pulled from C-D in my word list!
